A RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE SHASTINA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS TRANSFERRING DELINQUENT DISTRICT SERVICE FEES AND PENALTIES TO THE SISKIYOU COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR TO BE ADDED TO THE TAX ROLLS AS A LIEN AGAINST PROPERTY (PARCEL) TO WHICH SERVICES WERE PROVIDED BUT NOT PAID FOR.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Lake Shastina Community Services District, Siskiyou County, California, as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 61621.2 of the Government Code of the State of California a District may elect to have any, or all, rates or charges for any purpose collected on the tax roll in any forthcoming fiscal year, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 61765.3 of the Government Code of the State of California, the Board of Directors held a public hearing on 10 and 24 July 1984 to hear and consider all objections or protests, if any, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V of District Ordinance 4-80 a written report, which contained a description of each parcel of real property located within the District receiving services and the amount of the delinquency charges and penalties for each parcel in conformity with the charges prescribed by said Ordinance, was prepared and filed with the Secretary, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V of District Ordinance 4-80, the District Secretary caused notice of filing of said report and the time and place of public hearings on said report to be published once a week for two successive weeks prior to the date set for said hearings, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V of District Ordinance 4-80, the Board, upon conclusion of the hearing on the report and having considered all objections or protests regarding the delinquent accounts listed in said report, did adopt a final version of the report.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the District Secretary shall, pursuant to Government Code 61765.4 and District Ordinance 4-80, on or before the 10th day of August 1984 file with the County Auditor of Siskiyou County a copy of said report with a statement endorsed thereon over the Secretary's signature that said report has been finally adopted by the Board of the District, and that the County Auditor shall enter the amounts of the charges against the respective lots or parcels of land as they appear on the current assessment roll to be collected at the same time and in the same manner and by the same persons as, together with and not separately from, the general taxes for the District, and shall be delinquent at the same time and thereafter be subject to the same delinquency penalties.

MINUTES CONTINUED MEETING OF 10 JULY 1984 HELD ON 24 JULY 1984

This continued meeting of the Board of Directors was called to order by President Worsnop at 7:02 p.m. On Roll Call there were present Directors Dutro, Spahr, Trager and Worsnop. Absent: Director Barbier.

II. <u>APPROVAL OF AGENDA</u>: With Board approval, added to the agenda at the conclusion of the public hearings were) reinvestment of CSD funds,) invitation to a CSD Representative to address the individual membership meetings of the property owners associations, E) special district augmentation funds. With these additions, upon motion made, seconded and carried the Board voted to approve the Agenda.

III. PUBLIC HEARINGS:

- A. President Worsnop opened the <u>public hearing on Ordinance 3-84</u> which establishes sewer charges for previously uncommitted parcels. The Board concurred there was no necessity to have a second reading of the proposed ordinance in light of the fact that there were no proposed changes and there has been no public input, criticisms or objections. Director Spahr moved, seconded by Director Trager to adopt Ordinance 3-84. Upon vote the motion carried unanimously.
- B. President Worsnop opened the public hearing to consider all protests from those being considered for addition to the County tax rolls for unpaid service fees owed to the CSD. General Manager Smith read into the record a letter from Mrs. E. M. Mirsky complaining about the police fee for her unimproved lot and the high cost of maintaining this lot she will never be able to build on but can't seem to sell. He also read into the record his reply to Mrs. Mirsky. There was no public input with regard to the list of owners whose names and past due amounts will be turned in to the County Tax Collector. Director Trager moved the Board go forward with submission to the tax rolls, seconded by Director Spahr and upon vote the motion carried unanimously.
- C. Reinvestment of Funds After discussion and upon motion made by Director Dutro seconded by Director Trager, the Board voted to take \$50,000 in funds from First Interstate Bank and invest it in a certificate of deposit at American Savings and Loan and \$50,000 from the Great Western "super checking" account and invest it in a \$50,000 certificate of deposit with the same institution GW.
