

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

PERSONAL ITEMS TO HAVE READY (The P's)

- People and Pets (leashes, bowls, food, carrier)
- Prescriptions- including glasses, dentures, hearing aids, medical devices
- Papers- Important documents: ID's for each family member- Photo of children, Home titles and Insurance, Pet ID's, Health insurance cards, Marriage Papers, Bank Info Papers, Tax Papers
- Photos- irreplaceable pictures and heirlooms
- Personal Computer and charger
- Phone and charger
- Purse/Pocketbook- cash, credit cards, checkbooks
- Pre-packed suitcase, with extra clothes for each person (seasonal needs), shoes, toiletries, diapers
- Personal Vehicle: To keep ready in your car, not to try to find and pack-
At least ½ tank gas, blankets, first aid kit, flashlight, TP, food snacks, water, toys, books
If you have plenty of time and they are already organized: Camping gear, food, water, clothes

PREPARING YOUR HOUSE TO EVACUATE

- Do not try to take or move all of your vehicles. Do not park on the golf course. It may be needed for fire equipment, helicopters, or fire personnel
- Leave your front door locked, windows closed
- Check on your neighbors to make sure they are ready to leave, as well

NOTIFICATION METHODS FOR EVACUATION

- Code Red- have to be signed up through the Siskiyou County Sheriff's office ahead of time- will come through your phone (cell and home)
- Fire, Police , and CERT going door to door

EVACUATION

- Listen and Follow directions, Stay Calm, Encourage Cooperation
- DO NOT bottleneck the exits or get out of your cars to talk.
This blocks access for emergency vehicles!
- You will receive directives for going to shelters at that time.

OTHER PREPARATIONS

- Have a pre-arranged contact out of the area, which you can notify in the event of an evacuation
- Become acquainted with your neighbors, you may make a new friend and you may be able to help each other
