NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Laura Bynum, County Clerk, County of Siskiyou, that an election will be held in the Lake Community Services District in Siskiyou County on November 3, 2020. The following questions will be submitted to the qualified voters of the Lake Shastina Community Services District:

MEASURE J

Shall the Lake Shastina Community Services District, to provide continued rapid response for fire protection and medical emergencies to the owners and properties within the District, increase the existing special parcel tax for fire services to \$80 annually for improved parcels and \$65 annually for unimproved parcels generating an annual amount of revenue of \$271,240 and which will continue to be levied until repealed by the Board of by the voters?

NOTICE is further given that based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballot booklets for said election, the County Clerk's Office has fixed 4:00 p.m., August 7, 2020, as a reasonable date prior to the election after which no arguments for or against measure may be submitted for printing and distribution to voters. Arguments for and against this measure are limited to 300 words or less. All arguments must be submitted to the Siskiyou County Clerk's Office, 510 N. Main Street, Yreka, CA 96097, phone (530) 842-8084. Arguments may be withdrawn or changed up to and including the time and date set forth as the deadline for filing.

NOTICE is further given that specific requirements for submitting arguments are provided in the Siskiyou County Guide for Submitting Arguments and Rebuttal for Local Measures booklet, which is available on the County Elections website at www.sisqvotes.org or from the Siskiyou County Clerk's Office at the above-listed address.

NOTICE is further given that if arguments are submitted both for and against the proposed measure, the authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The County Clerk's Office has fixed 4 p.m., August 21, 2020 as the deadline for submission of rebuttals if such is required.

NOTICE is further given that the public examination period for analysis and arguments is August 22, 2020 through August 31, 2020. **NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the polls at said election will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
