



## COMMUNITY RELIEF FUND

**WHAT'S COVERED:** We are providing funds to individuals who have incurred losses as a direct result of the Mill Fire. They include:

- Temporary shelter, such as hotel or motel rooms or temporary rental housing
- Clothing, food and water, to provide basic clothing for you and your family, and to ensure you have enough to eat and clean water
- Transportation, for those whose vehicles were destroyed by the fire
- Medical care and supplies, for immediate needs for care and prescriptions
- Day Care/Child Care/Adult Day Care
- Lost income/lost business, for those whose jobs are unavailable because of the fire
